

FOUNDATION FOR HEALTH ADVANCEMENT RECEIVES \$150,000 FROM THE ALLERGAN FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT INNOVATION GRANTS

Princeton, NJ - March 2, 2020: The Foundation for Health Advancement, a 501C(3) not-for-profit organization that supports New Jersey researchers and students who are developing cures for diseases and solutions to health-related needs, announced it is the recipient of a \$150,000 contribution from The Allergan Foundation to support its Innovation Grant Program.

The Allergan Foundation's support creates *The Allergan Foundation Innovation Grant* which enables the Foundation for Health Advancement to provide one grant of \$50,000 per year for the next 3 years to support innovative health research at New Jersey-based institutions affiliated with the Foundation for Health Advancement: Kessler Foundation, New Jersey Institute of Technology, Princeton University, Rowan University, Rutgers University and Stevens Institute of Technology.

"The Innovation Grants Program was created to help address the funding gap that exists in between researchers' very early exploration and those ready to form companies," said George F. Heinrich, MD, Vice Chair and CEO of the Foundation for Health Advancement. "Through this program, the Foundation for Health Advancement supports researchers and students who have great ideas, but need funding and guidance to continue to develop their ideas into viable solutions to address health-related needs. We greatly appreciate The Allergan Foundation's support of this program."

Research supported by the Foundation for Health Advancement's Innovation Grants Program includes: early detection of dementia, using nanoparticles to deliver medicines within the body, a novel treatment for alcohol use disorder and the development of a rapid, low-cost method to identify the origin of an infection.
